

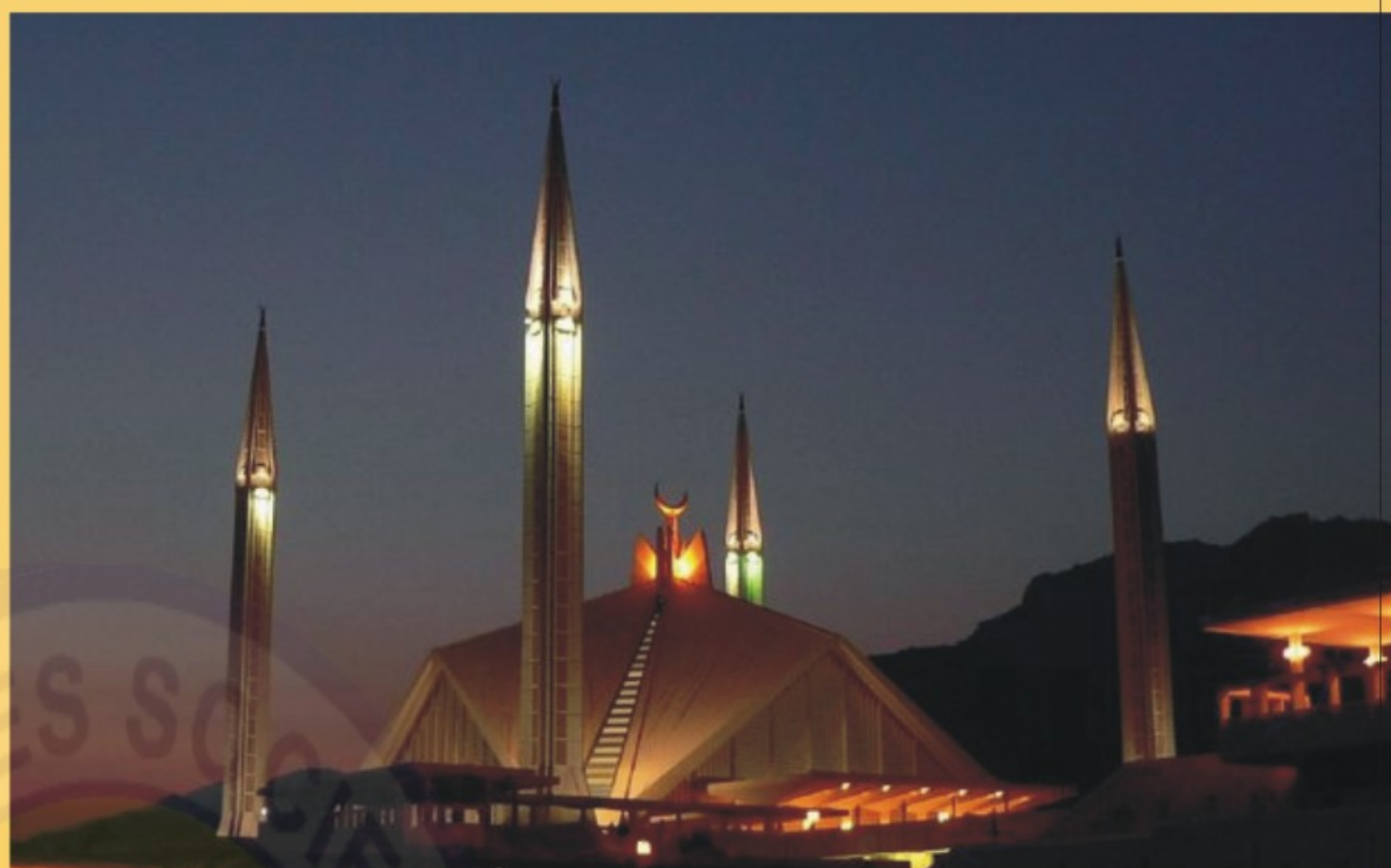
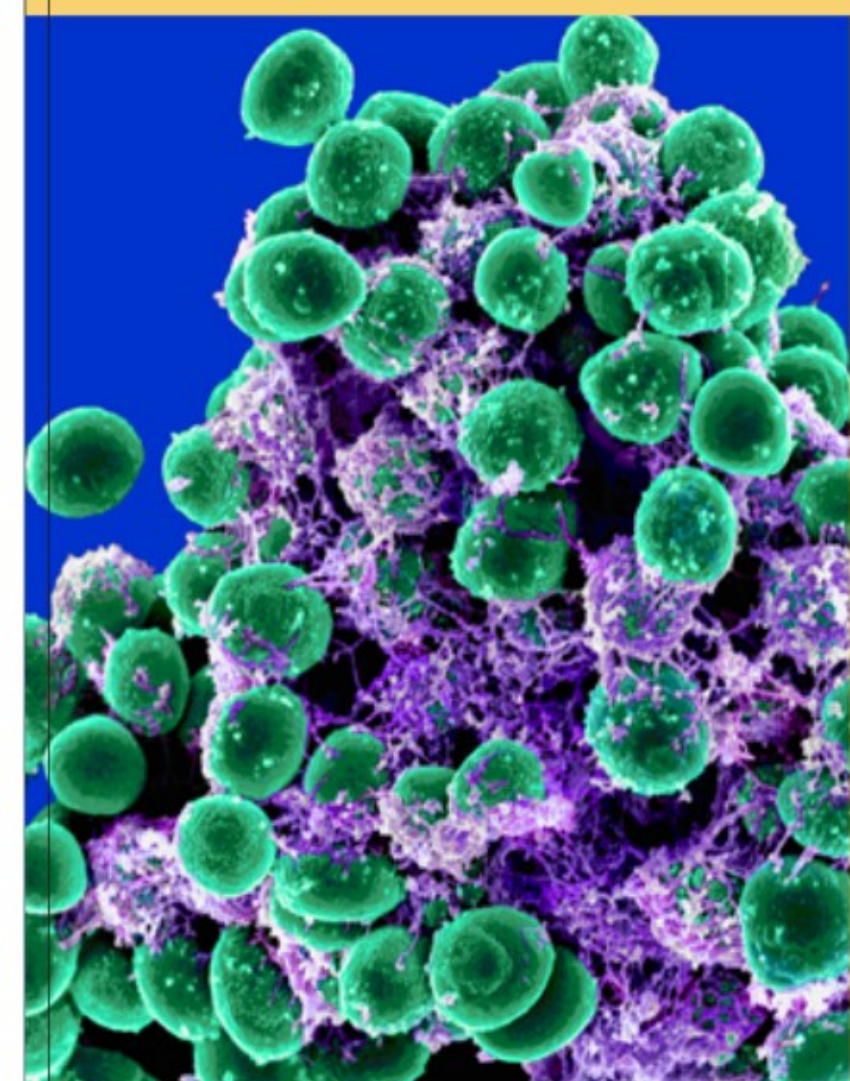

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS / POSTERS SUBMISSION

Oral:

- Abstracts may be submitted on any topic pertaining to clinical, epidemiological, diagnostic, therapeutic, and preventive aspects of infectious diseases in pediatric or adult medicine.
- Abstracts must be sent through Email as an attachment in MS Word. Fax or hard copy will not be accepted.
- Abstracts must contain original material. Single case report will not be accepted.
- Format should include Title, Name of Author(s), Institution, Telephone, Email.
- Please structure your abstract using the following headings: Objective, Materials and Methods, Results, and Conclusions.
- Abstracts written in substandard or vague language promising 'further discussion' will not be accepted.
- Abstracts must not be longer than 250 words.
- All abstracts will be peer reviewed before acceptance.
- Oral presentation must be made by the senior authors.
- Last date for Abstracts submission is February 15, 2011. After this date, printing of your abstract in the Abstracts book will not be guaranteed.
- Abstracts must be accompanied with completed Registration Form and appropriate Registration fee.
- You will be notified of acceptance or otherwise by February 20, 2011.
- Please submit the Abstract/Poster through email: idsp2011@hotmail.com.
- NOTE: Only abstracts sent by email will be accepted.

Posters:

- Abstracts must be sent through Email as an attachment in MS Word. Fax or Hard copy will not be accepted.
- Abstracts must contain original material. Single case reports will not be accepted.
- Each presenter will be allocated a display board measuring 3x3 feet.
- Posters should be visible from a distance of 1 meter; therefore alphabets 4 cms high should be used for the title. Use of colors is recommended
- The poster should be organized in sections: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Conclusions
- Senior author or trainee should present during the poster sessions
- Abstracts for the poster must be accompanied with completed Registration Form and appropriate Registration fee
- Last date for Abstracts submission for posters is February 15, 2011
- Three best posters will be judged for prizes

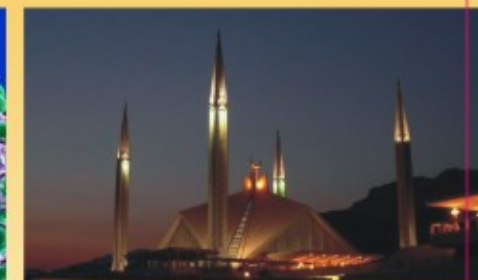
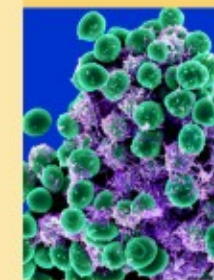
